Humanitarian Response by CHETNA NGO during Emergency COVID-19 Support generated by Ms. Sarah

The lockdown has affected street-connected families, migrant workers, and daily wage earners the most. And while the Coronavirus doesn't discriminate, the worst impact is on these lakhs of families who come from some of the most marginalized communities and are most vulnerable in this pandemic. The lockdown means they have to go without wages; they depend on donations to meet their everyday basic requirement - food, medicines, and even water. This pushed them further into poverty.

CHETNA NGO provided dry ration packs to **493** families included **1989** children and **1252** individuals with the help of the donation received from Ms. Sarah.

1.1-Total amount 2 Lakh and 50 thousand only.

1.2-Total families- We have reached out to 493 families, 1989 children, and 1252 individuals with dry ration packs.

- **1.3-Area Covered**-Under this ration distribution drive, we have covered 6 districts and 14 slums.
- **1.4-Total Ration packs-** We distributed a total of 493 ration packs to most marginalized families who are victims of lockdown.
- **1.5-The Selected Families** are Marginalised poor (street-connected families, single women, widows, migrants, daily wagers, rag-pickers) With NO Social Security (ration card, bank account, medical insurance, etc.). They have not received any COVID-19 released fund/ration/food from Government and also from any NGO.
- <u>1.6-Each ration can contain</u>-We have made ration kits containing 5kg wheat flour, 2kg rice, two types of pulses, 1kg Sugar, 1 kg Salt, 200gram Turmeric and red chili powder and a bar of soap required for a family of 4 for one whole week. Each Ration pack cost us around 500 rupees.
- <u>1.7-Other expenses This includes the transportation, labor, and safety measures of the distribution team.</u>
- **1.8-Accounts** -All these ration packs were purchased from the government-approved shops and GST bills were received. We have compliance with all the policies of the accounts.

1.10-Key Stakeholder- We have partnered with local authorities- Police, Childline, and Delhi Civil Défense Officers across the city to help us distribute these ration packs responsibly while adhering to the social distancing norms, to ensure the safety of team members and beneficiaries.

1.11-Future Scope

CHETNA team is on the ground reaching out to the most marginalized, especially the stranded migrant workers in the city and the workers who have no source of income and a bleak future. We are also reaching out to the homeless, beggars, and the rag pickers who have no access to ration or any social security schemes. We are striving to reach out to more 2000 families and for that, we will need 10,00000 INR.
